This will be an opportunity to work in a multi-cultural, multi-lingual and multi-ethnic environment and to put in practice what they have learned during their studies.

Profile and prerequisites

THE CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be a citizen of one of the Member Countries of the IOC¹;
- Hold a four-year degree or equivalent qualifications in business administration and management or similar;
- Have had some initial work experience;
- Have good knowledge of project management, budget monitoring, financial accounting and finance;
- Have a good knowledge of ERP and business management software;
- Have a good knowledge of Microsoft Office;
- Have a good knowledge of Spanish and at least one of the other official languages of the Organisation²;
- Be in good health.

IT WILL BE CONSIDERED AN ASSET

- Show initiative and be proactive;
- Knowledge of ERP software Sage X3.

Tasks

The main tasks of the trainee, who will report to the Head of the Financial Management Unit, will be:

- To collaborate on the management of the implementation project of the ERP Sage X3;
- To collaborate on the management of the IOC treasury;
- To collaborate on the close of the 2022 financial year;
- To collaborate on budget monitoring tasks.

Duration of the traineeship

Last months of the year 2022 (may be extended one year). The scheduled starting date is **16 November 2022**.

1 November 2022 (deadline for dossiers to arrive by post or email).
